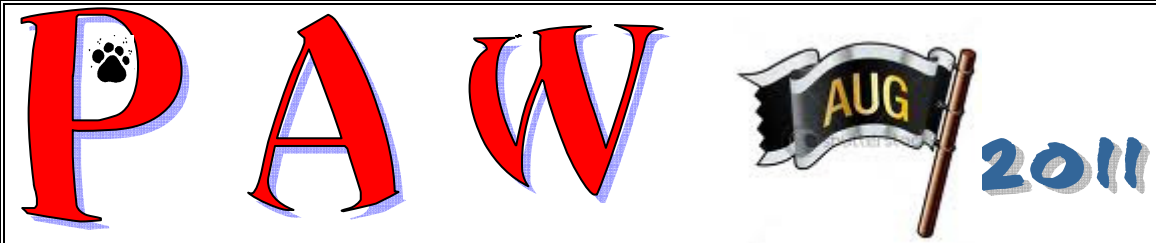
## MEET YOUR TEACHER & BACK-TO-SCHOOL BARBECUE! AUGUST 25, 5:30-7:30PM.....

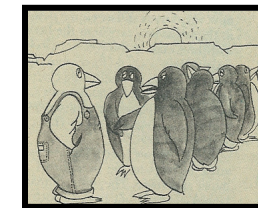

If you pick up your Lynnwood children at the Junior-Senior High campus, please do so at the crosswalk right on time. You will help us provide safety and avoid traffic jams. **NO supervision has been assigned at this time**, so please instruct your student to wait in the office building if you happen to be late.

## DRESS CODE

The dress code for PreSchool-6 is in your copy of the Parent Handbook (pgs 22-25) you received at the time of registration. Please read it carefully and call the office if you have questions. Carefully follow the standards given as you shop for school clothes; they are enforced as consistently as possible. Please note: Athletic shorts, cotton sweatpants, tight fitting, excessively oversized apparel, Lycra/Spandex clothing, flip-flops, and make-up are not acceptable. Shorts must cover at least 2/3 of the thigh.

Special Dress Days: Our CPCS-Lynnwood Spirit Day will be Green/White/Gold. We have Spirit shirts available for sale but supplies are limited. Our July PAW PRIDE listed the sizes available for purchase so please check it out on our website: [www.cpcsschools.com/lynnwood](http://www.cpcsschools.com/lynnwood). We will also have Christian Shirt days – wearing shirts with a Christian message on it.

Don't forget that our Chapel Days are on **THURSDAYS**, 8:45-9:45am. Girls are expected to wear skirts, dresses, and dress shoes. Boys are to wear dress shirts with a tie, dress pants and dress shoes. **No sweatshirts, leggings or tennis shoes may be worn on Chapel days.**

## THE FIRST DAY - FROM BEGINNING TO END

*We love each of "our" kids! In order to ensure safety in our parking lot and on our playground the following procedures must be observed (please see traffic map enclosed):*

### ➔FROM BEGINNING➔

**MORNING ARRIVAL** - Parents may not pull on to the Lynnwood playground to drop off their children. All children should be dropped off in the front of the school and walk down the breezeway to the playground. Be sure to stop at the speed bump and not in the crosswalk as you pull out. Do NOT drop off in the north lot. Use this lot only to park & walk with your child **through the courtyard or to the ECE rooms**. School begins at 8:30 a.m. Monday, August 29<sup>th</sup>. The classroom doors will be opened at 8:15 a.m. the first day only. Parents may escort students to the classroom or to the playground at that time. **Students should be dropped off no earlier than 8:15. If students arrive before 8:15, they will be taken to the Before-School Care and charges will appear on your monthly statement.**

Pre-School and Pre-Kindergarten parents: only students who attend school on Mondays will start August 29<sup>th</sup>.

Your child will start school according to the day you have chosen for them to attend.

**Pre-School and Pre-Kindergarten students may go directly to their classroom.** Parents may park in **the visitor parking spots to drop off and pick up.**

A student identification/dismissal sheet is enclosed and should be attached to your child's clothes or sent with him/her the first day of school to aid the faculty and staff in getting him/her to the proper classroom, carpool or bus.

### ➔TO END➔

Pre-School, Pre-Kindergarten and AM Kindergarten students will be dismissed at 11:15. Parents picking up Pre-School or Pre-Kindergarten students may pick them up at the classroom and park in visitor spots or in the north lot. AM Kindergarten parents should drive through the parking lot to the speed bump and wait for the students to be dismissed to the parents' cars. Grades K-2 will leave the classroom at 2:50 and grades 3-6 will leave the classroom at 2:55 and be ready for pick-up between 2:57 and 3:00. Shuttle service will leave elementary at 3:10. The parking lot is nearly empty by 3:00, **a great time to arrive** and avoid the gridlock.

### AFTERNOON DISMISSAL -

- Parents who need to get out of their cars must park in the angled parking or at the north or south end of the lot.
- ALL lanes of traffic must be continually moving so that the children can be picked up quickly and vehicles moved on and off the lot in an expedient manner. We must do everything we can to prevent backups on 64<sup>th</sup> Avenue. **Exit in the lane you are in without crossing the pedestrian crosswalks.**
- Parents in cars in the lanes may not leave their cars. Please stay in your car and keep the through lanes clear unless directed to be there. The faculty will see that the children are delivered safely to each car. Please be aware & careful as you slowly move forward.
- ONLY parents of kindergarten and first graders may come in the far left lane closest to the building for their children to be loaded over the curb. If you also have an older child, please stay in the other lanes, and all your children will be delivered to you.
- Your child(ren) will be admitted to after-school care at 3:05pm if not picked up before this. Once in after-school care, you will be charged \$5 per child per hour. Please come to the office if you are late picking up.
