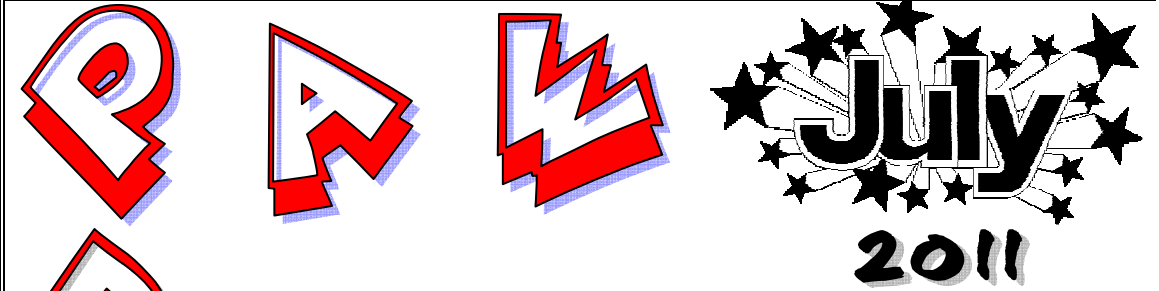
MEET TEACHER/BACK-TO-SCHOOL BBQ – AUGUST 25

CHAPEL DAY
