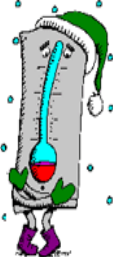
Please make note that the Chess Club is cancelled for December 13<sup>th</sup> because of the Christmas Program that evening.

## WAITING FOR A WINTER WONDERLAND

The best way to know if weather has caused a change in the school schedule is to access the school website – [www.cpcsschools.com/lynnwood](http://www.cpcsschools.com/lynnwood) or the Emergency Information Line: **425-953-4809**. Lynnwood will follow the announcements for the Edmonds School District. The TV/radio stations can take up to 45 minutes after the announcement is called in to actually have it on the air. However, you are welcome to also listen to these **radio** stations– **KCMS (105.3FM)**, **KCIS (630AM)**, **KIRO (710AM)**, **KING (98.1FM)** **KOMO (1000AM)** – for our decision to close school due to snow. The decision will be called in to those stations by 6:00 a.m. The following announcements may be made:

1. open on time
2. open late
3. no school

When school opens late, transportation will operate late. When school opens more than one hour late, there will be NO A.M. Kindergarten. If there is no announcement, school will be open. Shuttle transportation during inclement weather will be as close to schedule as possible. Your patience will be appreciated. Stay tuned to your radio and check our district website ([www.cpcsschools.com/lynnwood](http://www.cpcsschools.com/lynnwood)), especially if the weather changes. We may need to dismiss school early if the roads remain icy or the weather becomes worse.

The elementary library uses both fixed and flexible scheduling. Students visit the library every week for read-aloud, book talks, research skills instruction and book selection. The library offers Surpass Automation System for circulation and catalog. All elementary students are instructed in online catalog searching skills. Promoting reading for pleasure is a central goal of the elementary library program. Parents are urged to read aloud to their children through the grades. Parents may check out books for their child after school. Our library subscribes to CultureGrams, eLibrary elementary, and Proquest.
