Parents using lanes 2 & 3 must not leave the car to escort their children to class. Please have your children use the crosswalk. In the north lot, no cars are allowed to drive down into the playground. Please use the courtyard to walk from the north lot to the playground. Just a reminder — the right 2 lanes are to turn right and the left 2 lanes are to turn left when leaving the parking lot. Please do not cross over the lanes to exit.
