### LUNCH REMINDER - ORDERS DUE SEPTEMBER 26<sup>th</sup>

### EMERGENCY KITS DUE BY FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 23<sup>RD</sup>

If you are new to CPCS, please make one up and bring it to your child's class. It should be in a large sealable plastic bag and labeled with the child's name. A list of items for inclusion follows:

1 emergency space blanket, 1 letter of comfort, 1 pr. of socks, 1 sm. flashlight or "pinch" light (opt), 1 lg. 33-gal garbage bag (rain protection), 1 family photo, 1 stocking cap, note about special needs or medication, 1 pkg. Skittles (or other favorite), 2 pkgs. drink (like Capri Sun), 2 antiseptic wipes, 2 lg. bandages, 2 med. bandages, 2 plastic spoons, hand-warmers (opt.)

Include any 4 of the following: sm. container of pudding/spoon, fruit cup/spoon, cheese and crackers, fruit snacks, beef jerky, Vienna sausages, pkg. of raisins, granola bar

#### **NO peanut products please!**

The deadline for having the emergency kit to the school is Friday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>. Every child needs to be provided for as a security measure. Students who do not have a kit in the classroom by Friday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>, will be charged \$13 (even if a kit is brought to school the following week - no refunds) as we must special order them.

### BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL CARE

Morning before-school care for students grades K-6 is available from 7-8:15am. After-school care is from 3:05-6pm. Snacks are provided for both groups. **Children MUST be registered in order to come.**

### RESERVED PARKING SPOTS

### DRESS CODE QUESTIONS

Please read pages 22-25 of your Parent Handbook for guidelines.

- Shorts may be worn every day EXCEPT THURSDAY. They must cover at least 2/3 of the thigh.
- Athletic shorts, cotton sweatpants, tight-fitting, or excessively oversized apparel and Lycra/Spandex clothing are not acceptable.
- Jeans and/or shorts are to have no holes, tears, or frayed bottoms.
- Flip-flops are not allowed.
- Camouflage shirts or pants of any kind are not allowed.
- On Chapel days, **dress shoes are required for both girls and boys.** Girls are to wear dresses or skirts/ blouses; boys are to wear dress pants and button shirts with ties.
- Every year there is another fashion statement for girls and this year it is LEGGINGS!
  - Leggings are NOT to be worn on Chapel days (Thursdays) UNLESS they are worn under longer clothing where they can't be seen.
  - If "it's too cold" on Chapel days, we would suggest that your child wear tights.
  - The skirt/dress length when wearing leggings on non-Chapel days is still the same - no shorter than the top of the kneecap.



### PARKING LOT PROCEDURES FOR SAFETY

The parking lot woes are smoothing out. We love each of "our" kids! *THANK THE LORD* for His angels around our students as they enter and exit their cars.

- Stop at the speed bump; follow the arrows for exiting left and right from the lot without crossing lanes.
- Be careful not to block neighbors' drive-ways.
- Please arrive after 8:15 a.m. since we have no supervision available until then. In the afternoon, kindergarten is dismissed @ 2:45, 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> grades @ 2:50 and 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grades @ 2:55. Follow the teachers' directions for lane placement. Before 8:15am and after 3:05pm will result in Before/After-School Care fees.
- When dropping off children, please stay in your car in the 2 inside lanes in front. You may park in the front of the north lot if you are coming in and walk your children through the courtyard. You may also park in the lane in front closest to the street. Do not let children cross the lot unattended or be past the east buildings as buses need to exit from the playground area. **The north lot is not a drive through and drop off area.**
- Pre-School and Pre-Kindergarten parents should park their cars on the building side of the north lot (NEVER in the thru lanes) so that they may escort their children to the classroom.
