

Philosophy:

The homeschool program embraces the general philosophy of Cedar Park Christian Schools, addressing its educational practices from a Christian perspective by offering its students the opportunity to understand themselves and the world around them from a Christian worldview.



Purpose:

The purpose of the homeschool program is to train students to serve the Lord by setting high, yet realistic academic goals and standards of conduct. The program is designed to assist parents in the teaching of their children and to help guide their students through the educational process.

Curriculum:

Parents may select from a number of Christian curriculum resources such as Bob Jones, A Beka, ACSI, and Alpha Omega. Family responsible for purchasing curriculum.

Benefits:

- Establishes individual educational plans with each student.
- Teaches and evaluates appropriate study skills.
- Maintains contact with the parent and student.
- Provides Christian, certified teachers as academic advisors.
- Offers extracurricular activities at CPCS: sports, drama, music, and chapel.
- Offers classes on campus.
- Provides Stanford Achievement testing.
- Provides resource support.
- Reviews goals and academic accomplishments.
- Helps create individualized educational programs: fine arts instruction, mentoring, work-study, career training.
- Meets CPCS graduation requirements for a high school general diploma.
- Maintains all student records and transcripts.
- Provides counseling and career guidance.
- Provides correspondence education to students out of the region.
- Graduates may participate in the on-campus commencement ceremony with administrative approval.

Program Options

(following initial consultation with advisor [cost \$35.00 per hour]):

Category #1

Meet with advisor one hour per week. Parent does not meet Washington State requirement for homeschooling.
Annual tuition to CPCS=\$400.00
Annual tuition to advisor=\$1,400.00

Category #2

Meet with academic advisor one hour every other week. Parent does not meet Washington State requirement for homeschooling.
Annual tuition to CPCS=\$400.00
Hourly tuition to advisor=\$35.00

Category #3

Meet with academic advisor more than one hour every quarter. Parent meets Washington State requirement for homeschooling.
Annual tuition to CPCS=\$200.00
Hourly tuition to advisor=\$35.00

Category #4 *requires Administrator approval*

Meet with academic advisor a minimum of one hour every quarter. Parent meets Washington State requirement for homeschooling.
Annual tuition to CPCS=\$200.00
Hourly tuition to advisor=\$35.00

Costs:

- New Student Application Fee: \$25.00
- Registration Fee:
\$75.00 per year by 3:00 p.m. last day of school or
\$150.00 per year day after last day of school
- Materials Fee payable to advisor:
\$100.00 per year (does not cover books)
- Tuition payable to CPCS: \$200.00 or \$400.00 per year (please see Program Options)
- Tuition to advisor: varies - please see Program Options on reverse
- On-campus classes (grades 7 through 12 only):
Up to two classes may be taken (with administrative approval, space permitting). Charge per class is 1/6 of current on-campus tuition & material fee.
