Philosophy:

The International Student Program embraces the general philosophy of Cedar Park Christian Schools, addressing its educational practices from a Christian perspective by offering its students the opportunity to understand themselves and the world around them from a Christian worldview.

Spiritual Life:

We will cultivate in our students a developing relationship with God through Bible classes, weekly chapel services, retreats, and ministry opportunities designed to encourage a heart for service. We prepare our students to make choices that are consistent with a Biblical worldview and encourage students to be involved in a local church.

Academic Life:

Strong academics build a solid foundation and help prepare students for university. Teachers are well-qualified professionals who take a personal, caring interest in the lives of their students.

Social Life:

Our students and staff encourage international students to build relationships with American students and help them integrate into American culture.

Benefits:

- Cedar Park Christian Schools are approved by the State of Washington and accredited by the Northwest Association of Accredited Schools, Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), and Association of Christian Teachers and Schools (ACTS).
- Provide international students the opportunity to increase their English language skills.
- Help prepare students for entrance to college or university.
- Teach and evaluate each student via grade checks and report cards throughout the year.
- Offer extracurricular activities such as sports, drama, music, and chapel.
- Offer classes in a Christian American environment.
- Provide Stanford Achievement testing.
- Prepare student to meet CPCS graduation requirements for high school diploma.
- Provide counseling and career guidance.
- Provide weekly meetings with the campus international advisor.
- Oversee spiritual, academic, and socialization of each international student and communicate with parents and guardians.

English Proficiency Levels:

Level #1

Student must audit all classes, enroll in ESL class, and meet with a CPCS advisor/teacher three times per week.

Level #2

Student may audit some classes, enroll in ESL class, and meet with a CPCS advisor/teacher two to three times per week.

Level #3

Student will receive accommodation in regular classes and meet one to two times per week with a CPCS advisor/teacher.

Level #4

Student is proficient in English, integrates into all standard classes, and meet with a CPCS advisor/teacher once a week.

Test results for the TOEFL and/or SLEP tests required for entry into grades 7-11.

Note: While on campus, students are required to speak English only. Those students who seek out friends from the American student population and get involved in extracurricular activities are more successful academically, spiritually, and socially.
