Re-enrollment: Re-enrollment begins February 7th. All financial accounts must be current in order to re-enroll. Re-enrollment packets are available in the Office.

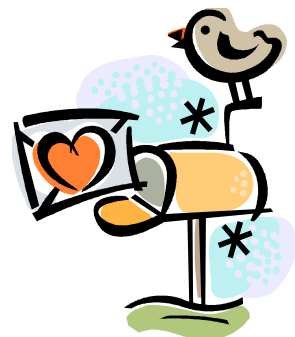
