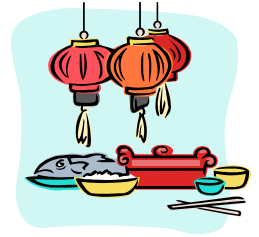


Senior Corner

Food: dinner will be an Asian-style banquet with teriyaki chicken and Mongolian beef; dessert will be served as well

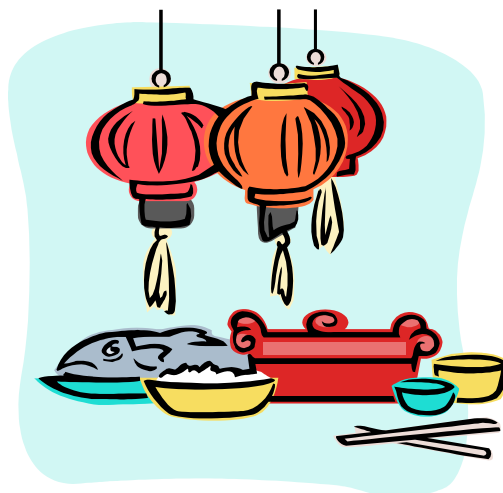
Dress: semi-formal
