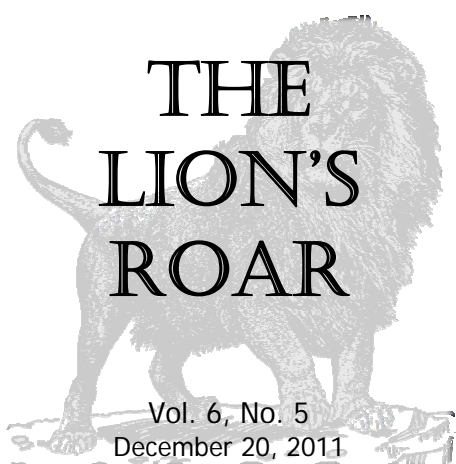


Vision

TICKETS ON SALE – BUY NOW FOR ENTRIES TO WIN A \$100 GIFT CARD: Buy your tickets before Christmas break to earn 2 entries per ticket into our drawing for a \$100 VISA gift card. Tickets purchased in January earn only 1 entry per ticket.

TICKET PRICING: The standard ticket price is \$30, BUT if you bring guests from outside the school family (this includes your extended family and friends), all of your tickets are just \$25 each. Tables are \$200 (8 tickets). All ticket prices go up by \$5 after February 17.

CLASS PROJECT CONTEST: The class from the MLT campus who's project brings the highest price at the auction will be getting special privileges, which are still to be determined - rewards to be announced in January.

PROCUREMENTS NEEDED: Now is the time to get those procurements rolling in! The expectation is for each family to either procure or donate at least \$100 in goods and services.
