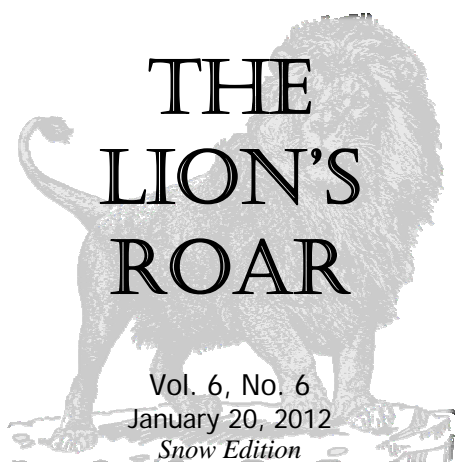


### Vision
