## Locker Assignments

\*\*Available beginning August 10<sup>th</sup> \*\*

Each student will receive a locker to use during the school year at no extra charge. Each class has a pre selected bank of lockers, with the Junior High located on the lower level and the

Senior High in the upper level of the school building. Please follow these steps in obtaining a locker.

1. Each student needs to provide a 7mm 9/32" combination lock (no key locks allowed), Master Lock is suggested. Students must keep lockers locked. If a locker is found in use with no lock and no card on file, the items will be removed and an office lock placed on it.
2. Students **must** have their lock with them at the time they come to choose a locker. Each locker has a card taped to the front. Students will pick the locker of their choice, from those available, fill in the card with the lock combination, sign it and turn it into Mrs. Beard in the office. **Locker Cards can not be removed to hold a locker.** Should a locker be found to have a lock and no card for it on file, the lock will be cut off. Students should practice opening their lock at home and keep a copy of the combination with them.
3. Students must note any damage that is present on the locker when they turn in their locker card to the office.
