## **Track**

Under the stellar leadership of long-time coach, Roger Gray, we facilitated the managing of the 1B/2B District track meet, held at Stanwood H.S., last Friday. Our ladies team repeated as the District champs, primarily due to the points accrued by seniors Catherine Oakland (a first, second and third in the field events) and Lynne Washio in addition to junior Jenna Otis (4-top 3 finishes in the sprints/hurdles). Lynne won her four grueling combination of events: 400M, 800M, 1600M, and the 3200M. Congratulations also go to Lynne, who has been named "WIAA/Seattle Times 1B girls State Athlete of the Week" for this week, which is the second time this year.



In spite of having only one senior, the boy's team had several personal-best performances that propelled them to a third-place finish at the District meet.
