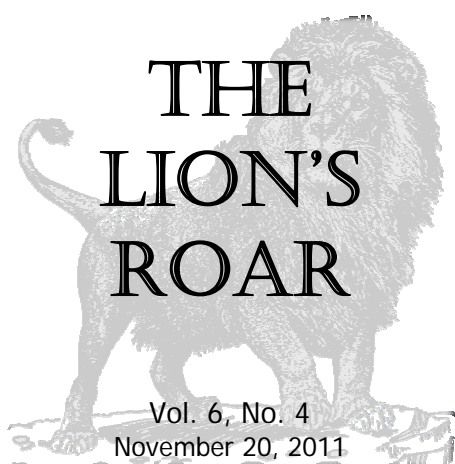


Vision

TICKETS ON SALE: Tickets for the auction will be available for purchase beginning the week of Thanksgiving at the campus offices.

WIN a \$100 GIFT CARD: We have a fun incentive for you to buy early – a drawing for a \$100 gift card. Tickets purchased by the end of November earn the buyer 3 entries into the drawing per ticket purchased. Purchase by the end of December earns 2 entries per ticket, and by the end of January earns 1 entry per ticket. The person who actually purchases the ticket is entered, not the attendee.

TICKET PRICING: The standard ticket price is \$30, BUT if you bring guests from outside the school family (this includes your extended family and friends), all of your tickets are just \$25 each. All ticket prices go up by \$5 after February 17.

CLASS PROJECT CONTEST: The class from the MLT campus who's project brings the highest price at the auction will be getting special privileges, which are still to be determined. We'll have more on this later.
