This year's team has a great team spirit and shows great heart. Here is a summary of one of our games to give you insight into who they are.

What a crazy thing! Three games in a row, three overtimes, three shootouts... and this game saw 11 players take Penalty Kicks. I sit here with my head spinning. In my career as a player and coach of 35 years, I have never had two games back-to-back go into shootout, let alone three. And I have never gone into *sudden death* shootout. Our boys have been experiencing something they will probably never again experience!

I shared with the boys at the end of regulation time: "Gentlemen, let me share a bit of history with you. In league play this year, Shoreline has never been scored on... until today; and you did it twice!" You could see them beam!

As we moved to the shootout, I struggled with what to say... and then it came, "I don't know how God figures into all this soccer stuff. Two Christian teams are playing. Does it matter? Does God play into who wins? I don't know. But I will tell you what I do know – He expects you, in everything you do, to honor Him in both words and actions. And when you do that, that is success; that makes you winners.

Today was the best game this team has played all year! From heart, determination, possession, communication, being mentally tough – it was all there today. I told them that this is the picture I want them to remember as to what it means to be a team and play great soccer. Well done Lions!

Cedar Park Christian Schools - Scrip Program

WHAT IS SCRIP?

Scrip is a gift card program which Cedar Park Christian participates in. The school buys gift cards from many different merchants at a discount and sells them at face value, thereby raising funds for families and the school.

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

As stated, each gift card is purchased at a discount and sold for face value. Once a year, the school will credit back the portion the participating family has earned. An example of a credit just for groceries is as follows: Family "A" buys \$500/month of QFC/Fred Meyer groceries. In 12 months, the family spends \$6,000. This family decides to utilize the Scrip program at our school and they would purchase \$500/month of Fred Meyer Scrip cards. The discount of the Fred Meyer Scrip is 4% therefore the family receives a total of \$240 in a tuition credit. This is just one example. **Please Note:** the participating family needs to accumulate a minimum of \$50.00 worth of discount percentage (profit) to have the tuition credit applied to their statement.

Scrip Order Due Dates: 10/14 10/28, 11/10, 11/23, 12/9

All forms must be turned into the School Office at Branch Campuses by 3 p.m. on these Fridays.

Scrip will be available for pick-up at the office or delivered home with your child (release required) by the following Friday.

The following Scrip Vendors will be available to purchase at anytime directly in the School Office:

QFC/Fred Meyer, Safeway, Albertson, Top Foods, Shell Gas, Arco and Starbucks

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: What is Scrip?

A: Scrip are gift cards or certificates that are used *just like cash* at the participating stores.

Q: Why buy Scrip?

A: Each Scrip certificate purchased directs a designated percentage of the purchase price back to Cedar Park families. This percentage differs with each individual vendor.

Q: Does Scrip cost me more money?

A: **Absolutely not! If you pay \$50, you get Scrip worth \$50. You pay the same but you also benefit from your planned shopping.**

Q: Is it really this simple?

A: **Yes! Here's an example: You pay \$100 and receive \$100 in Starbucks gift cards. Through the National Scrip Program, \$6.00 (6%) is given in *tuition credit* to Cedar Park families.**

Q: Does a little bit really make a difference?

A: **Definitely, the potential is huge! Consider if your family spends \$350 a month on groceries...Safeway credits 3% so that is \$10.50...times 12 months equals \$126 a year for your family account.** Q: How do I order Scrip?

A: **Complete the order form, attach a check (no cash) and deliver to the School Office. You have the option of having the Scrip sent home with your student or you can pick it up at the School Office.**

Q: How long does it take to get the Scrip?

A: **The following most frequently purchased merchants are always in stock in the Office for immediate pickup:**
~QFC/Fred Meyer, Safeway, Albertson, Top Foods, Shell Gas, Arco and Starbucks

Orders need to be received in the Office by 3 p.m. on FRIDAY dates listed above and Scrip is typically ready on the following Friday.

Q: So how does this new "Tuition Assistance Program with Scrip" work?

A: **Purchase Scrip. Fill out the Tuition Assistance Program form. The school records your purchases. Families need to accumulate a minimum of \$50 worth of discount percentages (profit) to have tuition credits applied to their statement. Accumulated amounts less than \$50 at the end of the Scrip fiscal year (February) will be automatically applied to the school Financial Aid fund. Tuition credits will be posted to your April statement.**

Q: How do we earn Tuition Credits?

A: **Each Scrip item has a discount associated with it. The Tuition Credit is the discount percentage of that Scrip item (see example at the top).**
