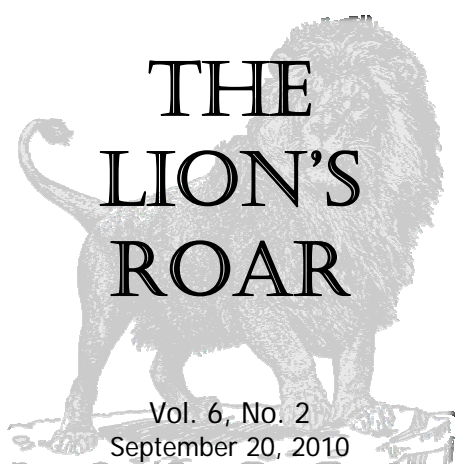


Vision
