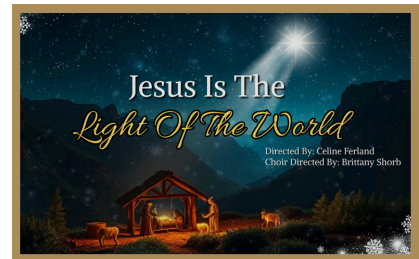

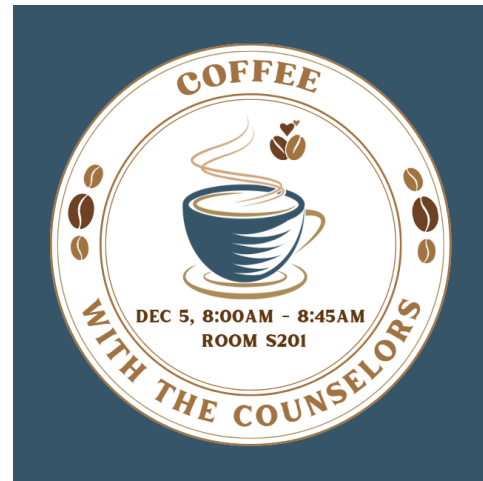

Traffic



The Bothell Police Department has been an invaluable partner with our CPC Bothell campus. They have graciously monitored 112th Ave the past few days for our students' and families' safety. They have kindly reminded us to inform drivers to **mind the school zone speed limit of 20 MPH.**

Reminders

Watch your speed on campus.

Please be aware, to promote the safety of all students, staff and visitors on our campus, that **your speed should not exceed 10 mph while driving on our driveways and in our parking lots.** This includes our back gravel driveway that is used when accessing the North Entrance. Thank you for continuing to drive slowly and safely through our campus!

112th Avenue is a School Zone.

Please remember that during drop-off and pick-up times, 112th Avenue (the road that runs in front of our campus) is a **school zone**, and therefore, the speed limit is **20 mph. Please slow down as you are approaching, entering, and exiting our campus!**

Be a friendly neighbor.

Additionally, please be aware of those who live in the nearby neighborhoods who are attempting to get in and out of their streets. Whenever possible, please take the time to **pause and allow them to exit or enter their streets** as a sign of our desire to be good and considerate neighbors.

Do not drive through the apartment parking lot.

The apartments and condos near the school have complained about increased traffic through their complexes caused by school families attempting to avoid the traffic signal at the corner of 112th Avenue. **Please do NOT use their private property as a short-cut to or from school.** Thank you for helping us be considerate of our neighbors.

Exiting the campus in the correct lane

Remember that when exiting the campus, during drop-off and pick-up times, those who are **turning left** (South) should use the **modified turn lane** as directed. When exiting **outside of the drop-off and pick-off times**, drivers should use the **normal designated turn lane** as directed by the road markings.

Use your blinker as early as possible

To help assist our traffic personnel maintain an efficient traffic flow, please use your blinker early to indicate your intention to turn, particularly when **turning left into the South entrance during drop-off or pick-up times.**

Inclement Weather Reminders

How are decisions made?

In cases of inclement weather conditions, Cedar Park Christian School, Bothell will follow the Northshore School District closure/delay announcements.

As always, in the case of hazardous conditions, each family should determine their comfort level and safety in choosing to travel to school or elsewhere.

How will we find out?

CPCS will be exclusively using internal notification systems including email and the ParentAlert feature of FACTS, which will send a text message directly to parents and students cell phones with any emergency information. Families should update any changes to their contact information through the Parent Portal to ensure they receive these important messages.

Important: DO NOT REPLY WITH STOP, to the test message as this will block future emergency text notifications. **Note** that the incoming alert will come from 31706; you may optionally choose to save this as a contact such as "CPCS Alert" on your phone.

What about buses on school delay days?

ALL BUS ROUTES WILL BE CANCELED WHEN A SCHOOL DELAY IS ANNOUNCED. Parents should plan for alternative transportation options when Bus Routes are canceled.

What about preschool on school delay days?

In case of a delayed start, all morning half-day preschool classes will be closed, and childcare for preschool children will also open late.
