Naviance Classroom Visits: We will be visiting 6th - 12th grade classrooms this month, helping students to learn about and complete their Naviance tasks. 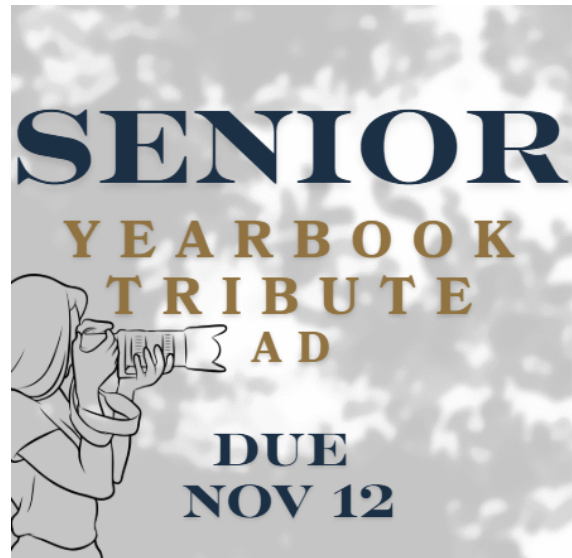
