

Theme: Atlantis, A City Under the Sea

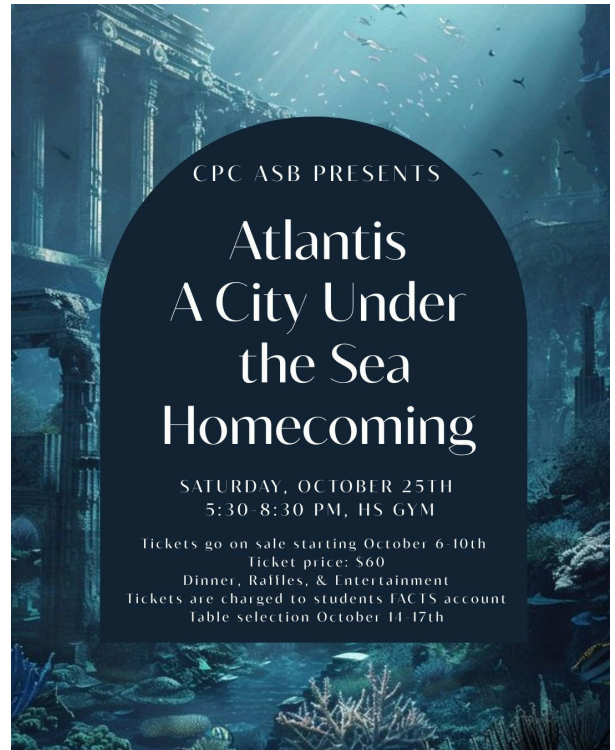
When: Saturday October 25; doors open at 5:30pm for check-in, raffles, photos, beverages, and appetizers. Dinner begins promptly at 6:15pm.

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CAMPUS SECURITY

CEDAR PARK CHRISTIAN BOTHELL

Cedar Park Christian Families,

We want to take a moment to inform you on the measures our school is taking to ensure the safety and security of all students while on campus and notify you that we are in the process of reviewing and evaluating our current protocols. The well-being of your child is our top priority, and we remain committed to maintaining and enhancing our ability to provide a safe and supportive learning environment.

The Bothell campus prioritizes safety through a comprehensive approach that includes visitor check-in protocols, active staff vigilance for unauthorized individuals, and strong partnerships with local law enforcement. School and church executive leaders meet regularly with Bothell Police and other agencies to review and enhance security measures, improve response times, and address new safety initiatives. Traffic safety before and after school is managed by staff and volunteers who monitor access and supervise crosswalks, maintaining communication for timely concern reporting.

The campus employs electronic security measures such as key card access for elementary classrooms and locked external doors on secondary buildings, with ongoing upgrades in progress. Annual emergency preparedness training and monthly safety drills covering lockdown, evacuation, fire, and earthquake protocols are completed by both staff and students. During weekly chapel services, external sanctuary doors are locked and monitored.

Communication systems for emergencies include the Parent Alert System via FACTS. The school is exploring further security enhancements like limiting car access during school hours and expanding monitoring of campus arrivals. An anonymous reporting system for students and community members has recently launched to facilitate confidential concern reporting.

A dedicated full-time safety employee conducts regular campus checks, and security cameras cover both interior and exterior locations. These measures represent a strong commitment to creating a safe environment supported by ongoing collaboration with local public safety partners.

Please see below for campus security protocols, reminders and updates:

- **Visitors:** Please be sure to check-in with one of our offices (Elementary or High School) upon arrival to receive a visitor's pass or volunteer lanyard. Without a lanyard/pass, you may be asked to leave.
- **Traffic Safety:** Before and after school, we have a team of staff members and volunteers who monitor access and supervise crosswalks while staying in communication to report any concerns.
- **Campus Surveillance:** Video cameras are a foundational piece of campus security and currently cover both interior and exterior locations across the campus.
- **Key Card Entry:** Elementary classrooms are secured electronically and accessed via key card.
- **Training:** Each year, staff members participate in Emergency Preparedness and Response training.
- **Sanctuary Security:** During our weekly chapel services, external doors to the Sanctuary are locked and monitored by staff members.
- **The Parent Alert System:** A feature of FACTS, used to communicate with parents and staff in the case of any emergencies and inclement weather.
- **Security Alerts:** An anonymous reporting system that provides a convenient and safe format for students and other community members to report possible concerns has recently launched.
- **Safety & Security Checks:** We have a full time employee serving in the capacity of promoting safety and security by doing regular checks throughout the campus.

Beginning Monday October 6th, both the **North** and **South Entrances** will be **closed during school hours between 8:30 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.** as part of our ongoing commitment to student safety and campus security.

All visitors and late arrivals should use the Main Entrance during these times. This adjustment helps us better monitor access to the building and maintain a safe environment for all.

Traffic



The Bothell Police Department has been an invaluable partner with our CPC Bothell campus. They have graciously monitored 112th Ave the past few days for our students' and families' safety. They have kindly reminded us to inform drivers to **mind the school zone speed limit of 20 MPH.**

Reminders

Watch your speed on campus.

Please be aware, to promote the safety of all students, staff and visitors on our campus, that **your speed should not exceed 10 mph while driving on our driveways and in our parking lots.** This includes our back gravel driveway that is used when accessing the North Entrance. Thank you for continuing to drive slowly and safely through our campus!

112th Avenue is a School Zone.

Please remember that during drop-off and pick-up times, 112th Avenue (the road that runs in front of our campus) is a **school zone**, and therefore, the speed limit is **20 mph. Please slow down as you are approaching, entering, and exiting our campus!**

Be a friendly neighbor.

Additionally, please be aware of those who live in the nearby neighborhoods who are attempting to get in and out of their streets. Whenever possible, please take the time to **pause and allow them to exit or enter their streets** as a sign of our desire to be good and considerate neighbors.

Do not drive through the apartment parking lot.

The apartments and condos near the school have complained about increased traffic through their complexes caused by school families attempting to avoid the traffic signal at the corner of 112th Avenue. **Please do NOT use their private property as a short-cut to or from school.** Thank you for helping us be considerate of our neighbors.

Exiting the campus in the correct lane

Remember that when exiting the campus, during drop-off and pick-up times, those who are **turning left** (South) should use the **modified turn lane** as directed. When exiting **outside of the drop-off and pick-off times**, drivers should use the **normal designated turn lane** as directed by the road markings.

Use your blinker as early as possible

To help assist our traffic personnel maintain an efficient traffic flow, please use your blinker early to indicate your intention to turn, particularly when **turning left into the South entrance during drop-off or pick-up times.**

Robotics



At Cedar Park we have 2 robotics teams! High School Robotics: CPR and Middle School Robotics: Eagle Robotics. Both teams are through FIRST, a world known organization empowering students to learn and grow in their STEM skills.

What is CPR and FIRST Robotics?

CPR is the Cedar Park High School [FIRST](#) Robotics Team. FIRST = For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology and is the world's largest STEM education program for youth with teams from over 100 countries. Cedar Park Robotics is a volunteer-led, after-school STEM program that combines learning, hands-on design/build/programming of a robot, and exciting competitions for Cedar Park High School students from the Bothell and Lynnwood campuses.

Cedar Park Robotics is recognized around the world as a top-tier, advanced technology team. We have reached the pinnacle level of success by being selected to compete at the FIRST World Championship 8 times over the past 10 years! To place in the top 10% of the world is a great accomplishment. Last year, CPR was ranked 33rd out of 3,690 teams – all with amazing, dedicated, smart Cedar Park students, and many miracles along the way.

Each year, both teams build a robot, program, and go to competitions.
