APPLICATION FEE Assessed <u>per student</u> upon application; non-refundable ; applies to students not enrolled in CPCS during the preceding school year. Paid to CPCS.	100 per student	Not applicable
ADMINISTRATIVE FEE Due upon acceptance of enrollment; non-refundable. One-time fee per family for the first child in K-12, *contingent on the family's continuous enrollment. *Charged to families with no K-12 students enrolled at CPCS during the preceding school year. Paid to CPCS.	500 per family Due upon acceptance	Not applicable
CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT FEE Assessed <u>per student</u> ; non-refundable . Due January 15 . Notification of intent to continue for the following school year is required by January 15 each year. Paid to CPCS.	Not applicable	150 per student
ADVISOR SERVICE FEE Assessed <u>per student</u> , per year; non-refundable . Paid directly to the Academic Advisor.	150 per student Due at first Academic Advisor meeting	150 per student Due at first Academic Advisor meeting

NOTE: Students in grades 7-12 may take up to two on-campus courses and/or participate in CPCS athletics contingent on space availability and administrative approval (additional tuition/fees will apply).

Washington State requirements for Homeschooling:

Under Washington homeschool law, the instructional activity must be provided by a parent who is instructing only his/her child(ren) and is qualified in one of these ways: (**documentation must be submitted to the program Administrator.**)

- Be supervised by a certificated teacher for one contact hour per week.
- Have earned 45 college-level credit hours, or one year of college.
- Have completed a course in home-based instruction at a post-secondary institution or vocational/technical school.

<u>WITHDRAWALS</u>	Annual tuition is configured on a full-semester basis. Installment payment plans are calculated based on 12 monthly payments beginning June, 2026 through May, 2027. Withdrawals require written notification to your campus admissions office.
Written withdrawal notification received after August 1st: Payment for the full first semester is required. Written withdrawal notification received after December 1st: Payment for the full second semester is required. Withdrawals during the school year will require a \$50 withdrawal fee (or \$25 if the student is transferring to a CPCS campus full-time).
